


#### Welcome...

## Appointment Etiquette — how to get the most out of your visits with us.

As we have become a busier practice in recent times we made steps to implement online booking, and SMS reminders regarding appointment times to assist clients in accessing our clinic facilities. Recently we have had increasing numbers of people failing to show for appointments, coming in late or cancelling without allowing adequate time for us to reschedule for someone else.

- We generally consult week days between 9am until 11am, then from 4pm until 7pm. On Saturdays we consult from 9am til 1pm. During the middle part of the day (except Saturday) we perform surgery. On occasion we can offer appointments at other times but this is decided on a day to day basis. Consultation is made by appointment only with exception given to genuine emergency cases.
- Most scheduled appointments are 20 minutes long. Please understand if a patient arrives late for their scheduled time, it can quickly make us run behind for other clients who are on time. If you miss your scheduled appointment time entirely, we may need to reschedule to another time or
- We have had to implement a cancellation timeframe of no later than 2 hours before your scheduled appointment. This allows us ample time to fill your appointment slot. Failure to cancel or attempting to cancel inside the 2 hours will incur a \$25 fee. This fee will be waived under extenuating circumstances.

While these measures seem harsh, please understand we want to be able to provide the best care to as many of our patients as possible. By having our clients understand that we want to be available to everyone when they need us and abide by these policies we hope to be able to provide better care for all.


